Society members chose From Poverty to Flourishing as the key issue where the Society can focus its efforts to impact policymaking and bring psychological evidence to the heart of government.

To help the Policy Team implement this campaign, we are seeking to appoint up to 18 members to join an Expert Reference Group (ERG) in 2020. We are looking for members who can demonstrate innovative approaches and real-life solutions to tackling poverty as well as those who work directly with experts by experience.

We are particularly interested in hearing from academics, researchers and practitioners who take a psychological approach to poverty and who can help us to understand the interplay of power, identity, relationships, motivation and place in maintaining poverty and inequality. Every effort will be made to ensure the group has a range of experience across domains, contexts of research and practice.

We welcome and encourage applications from people of all backgrounds. We particularly welcome applications from people with a disability, BAME and LGBT+ who are currently under-represented across the Society. We will also be seeking input from Experts by Experience.
